General Rules & Regulations

The Family Division will run a few virtual events in each of Culinary, Flowers, Homecrafts and Juniors for 2020. Entries to be submitted by photograph(s).

1. Prizes for each section are ribbons only for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. There is no prize money.
2. MAS will post the top 3 winners in each section on Facebook, Twitter and the MAS website. MAS will attempt to post all other entries on the MAS website. If you have an entry that you DO NOT want posted online, please notify the MAS office at time of entry.
3. Entries requiring a measurement must include a ruler/tape measure showing the actual measurements.
4. One entry per exhibitor in each class.
5. All entries will be judged virtually and the Committee Chairs of Culinary, Flowers, Homecrafts and Juniors will determine the placings in each section.
6. MAS reserves the right to make a decision in respect to all matters to do with the competition and that decision will be final.
7. Place item on a neutral colour, flat surface. Choose a location that offers good but not glaring light. Watch for shadows, especially of yourself taking the picture.
8. Entries to be submitted by September 15, 2020 at 6:00 pm. Entries to be submitted through Assist Expo – Virtual Family Division Competitions at www.assistexpo.ca/metcalfefair
9. MAS will only accept online entries.
10. How to enter: Please indicate name and class number on your photograph(s) at time of entry.

Classes

Class 1 - Culinary

1. Decorated cake, any theme. Judged on appearance only. Submit 2 photographs - 1 from the top view, 1 from the side view.
2. Lattice-top pie, full size, any filling. Judged on appearance only. Submit 1 photograph.

Class 2 - Flowers

1. Patio Planter with a list of the Flowers inside of it. Submit two photographs of your patio planter. One from the top and one from the front. Submit a list of flowers in the patio planter.
2. Largest Hydrangea Bloom – Take a photograph with a measurement tape in the photograph showing top to bottom of the bloom and the width of the bloom.



3. Best Fall Flower Bed – A photograph of the best part of your flower bed, with at least 3 different varieties. Named. Submit one photograph taken at least 3 feet away and a list of 3 different varieties of plants in it.
4. Junior Flower Class – Ages 6-13 – Submit one photograph of the ‘holiest’ Hosta.

Class 3 – Homecrafts

1. Quilt Block, not quilted, named. Submit two photographs, one of the front of the piece, one of the back.
2. Something New from Something Used, any medium. Submit two photographs, one of the front of the item, one of the back.
3. A collection of 4 (four) photographs with the theme “How I will remember 2020”, mounted. Labelling is optional. Submit one photograph of the mounted collection.
4. Sewn non-medical face mask, any design. Submit two photographs, one of the front of the mask, one of the back

Class 4 - Juniors

3 yrs. and under

1. 3 different kinds of leaves, mounted on paper. Submit one photograph.
2. Collection of stickers, mounted on paper. Submit one photograph.

4 and 5 years

3. Collage on construction paper with words/pictures from magazines, printed from computer or stickers of what Metcalfe means to you. Submit one photograph.
4. On a small paper plate, create a flower made of buttons. Submit one photograph.

6 to 8 years

5. Draw and design a sock. on paper. Submit one photograph.
6. A zucchini made into a vehicle. Submit one photograph.

9 to 12 years

7. Paint a picture of your favourite fair food. Submit one photograph.
8. 3 homemade cupcakes decorated for your birthday--on a small paper plate. Submit one photograph.

13 to 18 years

9. "Cup of Cheer"--arrangement of fresh flowers picked from your Mom's garden--in a special teacup. Submit one photograph.
10. Homemade dream catcher. Submit one photograph.
